Company Policy & Facility Information

In order to assure the comfort and safety of our guests, we require that all visitors wear proper personal protective equipment (PPE).

Clothing: Durable apparel is highly recommended, pants are required. Please avoid loose or dangling articles.

Hard hats and safety glasses must be worn at all times within the plant. The exception is the designated safe areas identified by a solid yellow floor. If you are not sure whether a hard hat is required in a specific area, please err on the side of caution until you can check with your host.



Footwear: High heeled and open toed shoes are prohibited in the plant. Closed toe footwear is required. Hard toe, protective footwear is recommended.

Hearing Protection: Ear plugs are available, but not required.

Smoking Policy: Smoking is prohibited in all areas within the 360 Lavoy Road facilities. The only designated smoking area is outdoors on the far north west end of building ten (10). No one may smoke along any path or walkway leading to/from the designated smoking area. This includes the lawn and the parking lots. Thank you for your cooperation.

Stay Connected

To access the internet while on-site at Automatic Handling Intl., Inc. (AHI), you may connect to the AHI_Guest WIFI Network.

The AHI_Guest Network is behind our firewall and incorporates the mixed-mode security protocol WPAWPA2-PSK (TKIP/AES). When you connect, we recommended that you classify the AHI_Guest Network as a public network and if given the option, do not allow your device to be discoverable to other devices on the network.

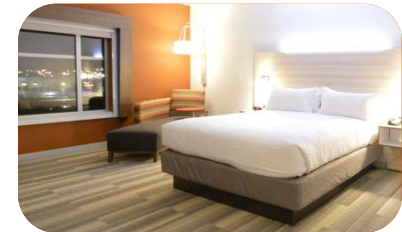
